



# Summer School Application

Los Gatos-Saratoga Union High School District

Dear Parent or Guardian:

Summer School 2019 will be held at **Los Gatos High School from June 17 – July 26**. Monday through Friday, from 8:00 am to 12:35 pm. In honor of the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday, there will be no classes held on **Thursday, July 4**.

The **deadline** for 2019 Summer School applications is **Friday, May 24<sup>th</sup>**. Applicants who enroll after May 31<sup>st</sup> may not be accommodated as classes may be closed.

Because of budget limitations, the 2019 summer program only offers courses for **remediation and make-up**. Students should consult with their Guidance Counselors about summer school plans. Those who feel they may need to repeat a class should enroll in Summer School, with their Guidance Counselor's approval, and withdraw if they receive a satisfactory grade at the end of the school year.

**Carefully review all of the materials before completing the registration form.** Most classes have specific prerequisites and parameters for enrollment; some requirements are specific to each high school. Make sure you complete all information on the registration form. **Incomplete registration forms will not be processed.**

Registration forms may be obtained through the Guidance Departments at either high school, or online at the LGSUHSD website ([www.lgsuhd.org](http://www.lgsuhd.org)). **Registration forms, including the required emergency card, may be turned into the Guidance Departments at Los Gatos High School and Saratoga High School beginning Friday, April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2019.**

**THIS WILL BE THE ONLY CONFIRMATION OF ENROLLMENT.**

#### Important Information:

- For students who attend Summer School, attendance is mandatory.
- There are no excused absences.
- Students are allowed 2 absences per 3 week session. Upon the 3<sup>rd</sup> absence, students will be dropped.
- Two tardies count as one absence.
- Exceptions **cannot** be made for vacation plans or other summer activities, so please plan accordingly.
- Students **may not** take their final exams early.
- Final exams will be given on the final day of each "semester" (session) of Summer School.

#### Reminders:

- Carefully read the course descriptions to make sure students do not attempt to enroll in courses for which they are ineligible.
- Have Guidance Counselors sign off on student's enrollment.
- Complete all information on the registration form and the emergency card.
- Confirm summer enrollment at either high school, or on the District website, on or after **Friday, June 14<sup>th</sup>**. Class schedules will not be mailed home.
- Students wishing to register must turn in a completed District Emergency Card with the registration form at the time of submission.

# Course Descriptions

Summer School 2019

## **\*\*\* Important Considerations \*\*\***

**Read the course descriptions before you register for Summer School.**

- Grade levels listed refer to the **student's current grade level**.
- Registration priority is given to upperclassmen.
- (P) – This indicates the course is college preparatory.
- All courses offered in 2019 are for students who need to repeat a course already taken.
- The 6 week summer program consists of two 3 week sessions. Each 3 week session successfully completed earns 5 units.

### **PLEASE NOTE:**

- Current 8<sup>th</sup> grade students are not eligible for the summer program.
- No **enrichment or accelerated** courses are offered.
- Classes may be cancelled due to low enrollment.



## **ALL COURSES ARE FOR REMEDIATION ONLY**

<b>Course</b>	<b>Grade</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Algebra 1:</b>	9 – 12	This is a course in elementary Algebra. <b>This course is only open to students who need to retake an Algebra 1 course.</b>
<b>Biology:</b>	9 – 12	This course explores the science of living organisms. Topics include cell structure and function, genetics, plant/animal taxonomy, ecology, and the human body. <b>This course is only open to students who need to retake a Biology course.</b>
<b>English 9:</b>	9 – 12	This course is designed for college bound students. It includes composition, language, vocabulary, and reading of selected novels/stories. <b>This course is only open to students who need to retake a 9<sup>th</sup> grade English course.</b>
<b>English 10 - 12:</b>	10 – 12	This course is designed for college bound students. It includes composition, language, vocabulary, and reading of selected novels/stories. <b>The course is only open to students who need to retake a 10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade English course.</b>
<b>Geometry:</b>	9 – 12	This is a course in plane Geometry. <b>This course is only open to students who need to retake a Geometry course.</b>
<b>Health:</b>	10 – 12	This course addresses a broad range of topics and is designed to promote student growth – physically, mentally, emotionally and socially. Topics include: personal safety, high-risk behaviors, emergency preparedness, CPR, and mental health issues. <b>This course is only for students who need to meet the Health requirement to graduate.</b>
<b>U.S. History:</b>	11 – 12	This course includes a review of the nation's early history and the major developments of the 20 <sup>th</sup> century. <b>This course is only open to students who need to retake a U.S. History course.</b>
<b>World History:</b>	10 – 12	This course develops students' understanding of western and non-western civilizations. <b>This course is only open to students who need to retake a World History course.</b>
