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2018-19 Food Service Program

In an ongoing effort to provide nutritional food items and quality service to our students, the Food Service Program will continue to feature a cafeteria line for Express School Lunches. The lunch will provide students with a nutritional meal that will include a daily a la carte entrée choice, a vegetable and/or fruit, bread/roll, and a 1% fat milk choice.

To increase the efficiency of service to our students the district has implemented the Meals Plus program. Parents may create an account for their student(s) and deposit funds that are then used to purchase meals. Go to: <https://www.k12paymentcenter.com/> for more information. Parents and students are encouraged to use this method of purchasing meals whenever possible.

The benefits of using Meals Plus are as follows:

See what your student is eating

Within your account, you can view up to 90 days of purchased cafeteria meals. This allows parents to find out precisely what your student is eating at school.

Set up a recurring payment

Automatic recurring payments can be set for monthly or weekly deposits, or when the balance is below a set amount.

Check a student's cafeteria balance

Log in to view your student's current meal account balance at any time. You can also see their running balance of meals and payments, or make a meal payment if necessary.

The a la carte program will continue with several choices of food items. Payment for a la carte items may also be made by using the Meals Plus account.

We encourage students' input and continued participation. Their input will ensure a successful program. Parents are also encouraged to volunteer. Students may apply to the Cafeteria Managers for lunchtime positions.
