Proposed Budget, 2017-18 Mr. Medici presented an update regarding planned Parcel Tax expenditures, 2017-18, noting appreciation for the support of the community and the participation of the members of the Parcel Tax Oversight Committee. Noted the following factors impacting the district budget for the coming school year:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 10% increase in medical insurance premiums • Increase in statutory benefits, e.g., STRS increasing by 2% • Step and Column increases for teachers of approximately \$80,000

Mr. Medici noted we plan to fund the same teachers but, with the above increases, Parcel Tax revenue will not cover the full burden; the difference will be made up by the General Fund.

Mr. Hult asked about the specific comment in the spreadsheet regarding 9th grade staffing. This was because the original vision of the Parcel Tax was to keep 9th core subject classes as low as possible, to ease the transition and provide as much support during that time as possible.

Mr. Medici noted the Parcel Tax revenue makes up approximately 2% of the district budget.
